

Basic Joinery I

Prerequisite: None

Enrollment: Limited to a maximum of four, with a minimum of two

Student Materials to Buy & Prepare Prior to Class: None - instructor will provide each student with the needed one piece of wood 1" thick x 3" wide x 30" long.

Description: Objective: To build 2 small boxes, using a Butt Joint and a Miter Joint both of which need to come out perfectly square. Tools, measurement, lumber and glues will be discussed. Table saw safety and operation will be reviewed and the class serves as an expanded refresher.

Fee: \$15 paid on-line during registration. This includes instructor provided material.

Tools: Will be provided. Bring safety glasses.
