Meeting was called to order at 9:05. Present: Peggy Sainato, Max Thompson, Fred James, Connie Riedel, Bill Riedel, Jim Booy, Sue Trevisan, Roger Lansberry, Dave Boulet

Approval of last meeting's minutes with no corrections needed

- I) Treasurers report -Roger
 - A) We have \$24,000 in our regular account, and "everything is going along ok"
 - 1) 14 new members have signed up for next weeks Orientation Class
- 2) Cash reserves will pick-up now that people are coming in and Christmas party and picnic tickets will be sold
- B) Roger suggests that new members who would like to sign up for orientation and classes sign-up online or if they have a problem with that, see Roger or another board member for help with the online signup and payment process. We will have more online sign-up training
- C) Roger has purchased a scanner to digitize all of the prior and present financial records for computer storage. We don't need to save most document on paper anymore.
- II) Conversation about Orientation signups
 - A) Getting new members on-line needs to be a priority
- 1) We have been having a problem with illegible sign-up information on the signup sheets. We need to train members to use the online method, with help from Roger if they want to use cash or checks.
 - B) Discussion of people who are no-shows for orientation
 - 1) Can these members be refunded? Yes, easier if paid online
 - 2) Written checks are not deposited until member comes to orientation
- C) Peggy brought up troubles with making corrections in the member database that get overwritten from Quickbooks import, and will work with Roger to get corrections into Quickbooks so that the mistakes do not replicate into the member database.

- III) Special Projects Access to Lumber Room
- A) Right now Dave Hill has access to the Lumber Room. It was suggested that we need to find a few more volunteers who can help with the lumber room sales. These people would be able to cover in an emergency
- B) Bill suggests building a Sample Board of the wood available to show interested people instead of opening the room when closed.
- 1) Samples could show raw, unfinished wood, and finished wood. The board liked this idea very much.
 - 2) Roger will oversee this project
- IV) Gary Rippentrop has volunteered to fill in as Training Coordinator and has met with Peter Meyer to learn more about the process. Thank you Gary!!

V) Office Remodel

- A) Countertop was delivered and installed Thurs morning at 7am
- B) Max Thompson has painted the office walls and floor with Joni's help and the office is starting to come together. There is still work to be done but this should be over soon.

VI) Powermatic delivery of new Lathe

A) Peggy reported that the new lathe was shipped Tuesday September 25th – it is being trucked from Tennessee. We need to uncrate the new lathe very carefully as we have to use the packing material to repack the old lathe for shipping back to the company. Bill suggests that rep should be here to set upon oversee hook-up. We will see if that is a option.

- A) We have more than 13 6ft tables signed up right now
- B) Ed Gallardo is looking for more tables, and Peggy will attend meeting Oct 4th.
- C) Sell Hats at Fair? We are still waiting for an answer to that question.

- A) Discussion of members not signing in
 - 1) Members Must sign in even if all they are doing is monitoring
 - a) This is a safety concern to know who is in shop
 - b) Numbers of people using the shop are reported to Rec Center
- B) Peggy will address this at Membership Meeting
- C) Discussion of correcting Website of online misconceptions

V) Discussion of a possible Lathe Committee

A) Suggestion to open Lathe Group as we have a Carving Group to share ideas,

and projects

- 1) Max suggests need to look for a leader in this group
- 2) Have Norm start proposal as he has interest in this. This group could handle the certification of new members who want to use the lathes

VI) Toy Program

- A) Sally is taking lead in this. Thank You!
 - 1)Robert is doing a few Bat Mobiles
 - 2) Heart Boxes need flocking
 - 3) Jerry is making doll beds

VII) Replacement of Green Lathe?

 - a) Crewman would teach at his specialized machine
 - 2) Will discuss this idea with Robert

 - 1) discussion of lathe safety
