

## Make a Raised Panel Door - Advanced Router

**Instructors:** Gary Rippentrop

**Prerequisite:** Must have completed Router Basics (or permission of lead instructor)

**Schedule.** Normally held once per quarter on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month in the quarter, from 3 - 6 PM (verify dates and times using on-line wood club monthly calendar).

**Enrollment:** Limited to a maximum of two students, with a minimum of one.

**Student Materials to Buy & Prepare Prior to Class:** None - instructor will prepare a total of 5 pieces of wood for each student. These include 4 pieces of door-edge - all finished to same size (3/4 inch thick x 2-1/4 inches W x 18" L), and one door panel (3/4 inch thick x 6" W x 16" L)

**Description:** Learn to make rail and stile door frames and raised panels that actually fit the first time. You will learn about router requirements, tables, bit selection and stock preparation. Each student will complete a standard raised panel door. This is an advanced router class.

**Fee:** \$15 - this includes class and pre-purchase / preparation of material by instructor.

**Tools:** Table-mounted routers and router bits are provided.
